The South Australian Junior Chess League takes much pleasure in inviting you to take part in one of the great chess events of the decade – the Lidums Australian Junior Chess Championships which will be held here in Adelaide in the first two weeks of January 2009.

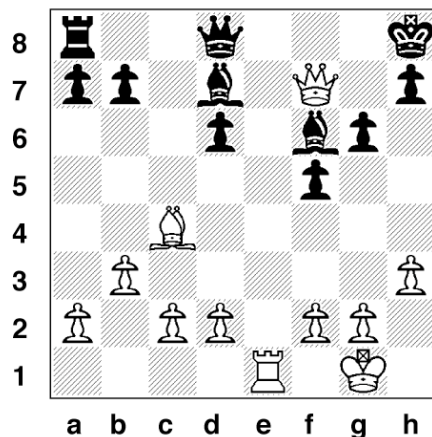
The Championships will attract the very best junior players from SA and around the country but are also intended to be a showcase for all juniors interested in playing the game – to this end, we are delighted to offer **two extra short tournaments** just for youngsters who want to try a real chess event but lack the confidence to take on the more experienced players.

- There are four Championships – Under 18 Open, U18 Girls', Under 12 Open and Under 12 Girls'. Each tournament is scheduled to have 11 rounds but this may be changed for the Girls' Tournaments depending on entries.
- A double round is scheduled for the 3rd day - before the rest day.
- **Two Novice events will be held over 4 afternoons in the middle of the tournament.** These will be played at a time rate of 30 minutes per player for the whole game - and there will be two games per afternoon - the first at 1pm and the second at 2.15pm.

The **Problem Solving Competition** will be great fun – and there will be a special prize for adults who wish to take part.

The **Lightning Competition** is fast – just 5 minutes per player while the **Rapid** is 20 minutes per player + 10 secs per move.

The Championship games have much longer time limits.
